PAYMENT

TOUR ITINERARY

Friday, September 9: Depart for Portsmouth

5:30AM- Motorcoach will depart from Lancaster, AC Moore Store, at the Lancaster Shopping Center on the Oregon Pike/ Route 272 side of the store.

6:30AM- Motorcoach will depart from Harrisburg, AAA Central Penn, 2301 Paxton Church Rd; travel to Portsmouth, NH with appropriate rest and meal stops en route.

Welcome to historic Portsmouth, New Hampshire! This city regularly lands on various "best places to live" lists. It was named as one of the top 100 walking cities in America, and the National Trust for Historic Preservation named Portsmouth to its list of America's Dozen Distinctive Destinations, calling the city "one of the most culturally rich destinations in the country." Upon arrival, we'll receive a warm greeting from our local guide along with a refreshing welcome reception! Tonight we will have a delicious dinner at one of the area's great restaurants! Hotel: Hampton Inn & Suites, Portsmouth, NH (Dinner)

Saturday, September 10: Harbor Cruise, Portsmouth tour & Hampton Beach Seafood Festival

After breakfast, we'll set sail for a scenic cruise out of Portsmouth Harbor. This narrated cruise will take you through nearly 400 years of local and American history, from the settlement of the region in 1623 to Portsmouth Harbor's modern day role in the economy and defense of our country. Learn about Portsmouth's history dating back to the 17th century, as we enjoy a walking tour along part of the Portsmouth Harbour Trail, encompassing the city's quaint downtown, waterfront and neighborhood streets. Sunday, September 11: Portland, Freeport, & Penobscot Narrows Observatory

The Old Port Exchange on the thriving waterfront was the heart of Portland's busy 19th century commercial ventures and continues to be the center of activity today. A one minute ride on the fastest elevator in Maine, New Hampshire and Vermont will take you to the top of the tallest public bridge-observatory in the world. This afternoon, arrive at Mount Desert Island to check into our hotel for a relaxing two night stay. Relax and enjoy our resort amenities and surroundings. Monday, September 12 : Acadia National Park & Whale Watch Cruise

You will have some free time in Dock Square. The center of town offers a variety of galleries and craft shops. Then continue on through The York's with a picture stop to one of the most photographed lighthouses in the world; Cape Neddick Lighthouse, more popularly known as "the Nubble". Set on a small island just a stone's throw off the coast of the town of York, the light and the keeper's house are on a small island surrounded by crashing waves. Then journey onto Ogunquit and nearby Perkins Cove. This afternoon, board the Finest Kind Cruises for a first hand lobstering experience!
