Welcome to the Disney Dining Plan,

which offers a convenient and affordable way to enjoy snacks and meals at over 100 select restaurants throughout *Walt Disney World®* Resort, including some restaurants that feature Disney Character Dining! From contemporary to casual, elegant to enchanting, you can find a great meal that fits your style. This brochure outlines the details of what is included and how to use the Disney Dining Plan.

Number of Meals During Your Package Stay

The Disney Dining Plan includes one (1) Quick Service Meal, one (1) Snack, and one (1) Table Service Meal per person, per night of your package stay for everyone in the party ages 3 and over.

Using Your Meals

- Use your meals and snacks in any order throughout your package stay until your total is depleted.
- All unused meals and snacks expire at midnight on your package reservation checkout date.

GREAT TIP!

You can continue using meals/snacks in any order during your package stay until each person has depleted his/her allotted meals/snacks. For example, if you use all your snacks on the first day, that will leave zero snacks for the remainder of your stay.

You can also find select Snack locations throughout the Walt Disney World[®] Resort.



Most Quick Service locations, outdoor food carts and merchandise locations selling frozen ice-cream novelties, popcorn, or Coca-Cola® products accept your Disney Deluxe Dining Plan.

Redeeming Your Meals

- Present your Key to the World card to the server or cashier at the time a meal or snack is purchased and specify the number of meals or snacks being redeemed for Guests ages 10+ on your Disney Deluxe Dining Plan and the number of meals or snacks being redeemed for Guests ages 3-9 on your Disney Deluxe Dining Plan.
- You may **not** redeem meals or snacks for any Guests who are not on your Disney Dining Plan.

GREAT TIP!

When dining with another party who is also using their Key to the World card to redeem their meals, please notify the server which meals belong on which Disney dining plan.

- The following items are some of the items not included in the Disney Dining Plan:
 - Alcoholic beverages and some bottled drinks
 - Souvenir or refillable drink mugs
- Snacks and beverages from recreation rental counters
- Glow Cubes
- Merchandise and Photo Imaging
- Gratuities are not included unless otherwise indicated. An automatic 18% gratuity charge will be added to your bill for parties of 6 or more. An automatic gratuity charge may also be added to your bill for items you order that are not included in the Disney Dining Plan (e.g. alcoholic beverages).
- The Disney Dining Plan is unavailable for Guests under the age of 3, but they may share from an adult plate at no charge, or a meal may be purchased from the menu. The price of the meal will be added to your bill. Guests ages 3-9 must order from a children's menu where available.

Tracking Your Meals

Your meal usage will be tracked electronically to your package reservation.

The example below illustrates a party with 2 Guests ages 10+ and 2 Guests ages 3-9 utilizing one of their Quick Service meal entitlements:

Each time you redeem meals or snacks from your Disney Dining Plan, the server or cashier will provide you with a receipt showing the meals and snacks remaining on your Disney Dining Plan. You can also contact your hotel concierge at any time for your meal plan balance.

Table Service Meals



Advance reservations are strongly recommended. Gratuities are not included. The Disney Dining Plan is unavailable for Guests under the age of 3, but they may share from an adult plate at no charge, or a meal may be purchased from the menu. The price of the meal will be added to your bill. Guests ages 3-9 must order from a children's menu where available.

Character Dining The Disney Dining Plan can be used for Character Dining experiences. One (1) Table Service meal for each person participating in the Character Dining experience will be redeemed from your meal plan balance, unless otherwise noted. Gratuities are not included.

Please Note: Two @ Table Service meals for each person dining at Cinderella's Royal Table will be redeemed from their meal plan balance. Gratuities are included.

Advance reservations are strongly recommended. Merchandise or photo imaging products that may be offered at Character Dining experiences are not included, except at Cinderella's Roval Table and Akershus Roval Banquet Hall. The Disney Dining Plan is unavailable for Guests under the age of 3, but they may share from an adult plate at no charge, or a meal may be purchased from the menu. The price of the meal will be added to your bill. Guests ages 3-9 must order from a children's menu where available.

Signature Restaurants

Disney Signature Restaurants provide unparalleled cuisine served in elegant and relaxed surroundings. Choose from a selection of menu offerings, including children's favorites.

Each Signature Restaurant Meal includes one (1) single serving: Appetizer (Guest ages 3-9 only) Tentrée 🕈 ♥ Non-alcoholic beverage 🕈 Dessert

Two @Table Service meals for each person dining at a Signature Restaurant will be redeemed from their meal plan balance.

Advance reservations are strongly recommended. Gratuities are not included. Dress Code for Signature Restaurants is Business Casual. Not permitted in dining room: Tank tops, swimsuits or swimsuit cover-ups, hats for gentlemen, cut-offs, or torn clothing of any kind. The Disney Dining Plan is unavailable for Guests under the age of 3, but they may share from an adult plate at no charge, or a meal may be purchased from the menu. The price of the meal will be added to your bill. Guests ages 3-9 must order from a children's menu where available.

Dinner Shows

The Disney Dining Plan can be used for Category 2 or Category 3 seating at all Dinner Shows (subject to availability) and Category 1 seating at the 9:30pm Hoop-Dee-Doo Musical Revue (subject to availability). Dinner Show experiences include: Hoop-Dee-Doo Musical Revue, Mickey's Backyard BBQ (seasonal), both located at Disney's Fort Wilderness Resort & Campground, or Disney's Spirit of Aloha Show at Disney's Polynesian Resort. Dinner Shows offer family-style dining with live entertainment show performances throughout the meal, themed to the Resort setting.

Show tickets can be acquired through Concierge. All Dinner Shows require Advance Reservations. Gratuities are included. Two 2 Table Service meals for each person dining at a Dinner Show will be redeemed from their meal plan balance.

- **Q.** Are reservations required?
- A. Our Table Service restaurants, character dining and dinner shows book quickly and the restaurant and seating of your choice may be limited or may not be available during your visit. Please call 407-WDW-DINE or go online to disneyworld.com/dining to make reservations up to 90 days prior to your visit for the best options. Reservations are accepted at most *Walt Disney World*® Table Service restaurants, Signature Restaurants, and Character Dining locations. Advance reservations are required for Dinner Shows and *Grand Gathering Experiences*.
- \mathbf{Q} . How do I make reservations?
- A. Just call Disney Dining at **407-WDW-DINE** (407-939-3463) or go online to disneyworld. com/dining. An accepted major credit card guarantee is required for reservations at certain locations. Reservations must be cancelled at least 48 hours (6 days for Grand Gathering Experiences) before the scheduled seating time or a cancellation charge may be incurred (charge varies by location). Please indicate any food allergies or other healthrelated dietary restrictions at the time of booking. We are happy to discuss with you and attempt to accommodate your special dietary requests.
- ${f Q}$. Can Guests ages 3-9 order anything off the menu?
- A. No, Guests ages 3-9 must order from a children's menu, where available. Many children's menus offer healthy options in addition to kid favorites. The Disney Dining Plan is unavailable for Guests under the age of 3, but they may share from an adult plate at no charge, or a meal may be purchased from the menu. The price of the meal will be added to your bill.
- ${f Q}.$ Can Guests ages 10+ use Guests ages 3-9 meal entitlements?
- A. Sorry, meal entitlements can not be shared between Guests ages 10+ and Guests ages 3-9.
- **Q.** Must I use exactly 1 Table Service, 1 Quick Service and 1 Snack each night of my package stay?
- A. No, for maximum flexibility, meal entitlements can be used whenever you like during your package stay. For example, one night you may wish to hold off using a Table Service meal and then the following night use 2 Table Service meals to dine at a Signature Restaurant or Dinner Show (subject to availability).
- **Q.** Are gratuities included?

Frequently Asked Questions

- A. No, gratuities are **not** included unless otherwise indicated. An 18% gratuity will be added automatically for parties of 6 or more. A gratuity may also be added automatically for ordered items that are not included in the Disney Dining Plan (e.g. alcoholic beverages).
- ${f Q}.$ How will I be able to keep track of the number of meals used?
- A. After you dine, your party's remaining meals for that meal type (Table Service, Quick Service or Snack) will be printed on the receipt. You can also stop by the Concierge of your hotel for a complete printout of meals used/available.
- ${f Q}$. Do any restaurants have a dress code?
- ${f A}_{f \cdot}$ Yes, the following Signature Restaurants have a business casual dress code:
 - ♥ Artist Point at Disney's Wilderness Lodge
 - ♥ California Grill at Disney's Contemporary Resort
 - 🐨 Cítricos at Disney's Grand Floridian Resort & Spa
 - ♥ Flying Fish Cafe at Disney's BoardWalk Resort
